Ascend Parent Initiative

Ja'Bette Lozpone, Director of Student Affairs, and Beverly Coleman, Director of MC Educational Opportunity Center

- Aspen Postsecondary Success for Parents Initiative at MC
 - Student parents are a large, often invisible high-risk population with high stop out and dropout rates.
 - Many are impacted by food insecurity, housing insecurity, and homelessness.
 - Purpose – systematically identify parenting students
 - Center and amplify parent voices and experiences
 - Expand opportunities, implement strategies and innovations to support parenting students
 - How can MC improve support to parenting students at the micro and macro level?
 - Assess, leverage, and build capacity through a lens of equity and inclusion and a culture of care
 - Two Generation (2Gen) Approach – move child and parent towards educational success and economic security
 - How will we accomplish our work?
 - Increase campus dialogue about student parent issues
 - Identify and hear from student parents
 - Collect institutional data about student parents
 - Increase visibility of existing supports and improve services
 - Learn about practices at other schools
 - Develop recommendations and an Action Plan
 - Where are we in the process at MC?
 - Formed task force, profiled existing resources, and identified challenges
 - Fall 2020 Accomplishments
 - Student Success Lead and API Taskforce Co-Stewards identified
 - Core taskforce composed of Student Affairs representatives convened five times
 - Invitations to Extended taskforce comprised of Collegewide representatives from critical areas of the College were finalized
 - Preliminary recommendations for Spring 2021 are ongoing
 - Action plan submitted to Ascend in December 2020
 - Extended Task Force Membership – some have personal experience
 - 3 subcommittees: Research and Data, Communications and Messaging, and Programming and Engagement
 - Goals for Spring 2021
 - IRB Approval for an internal self-evaluation/needs assessment
 - Administer survey and focus groups
 - Begin amplifying and centering parenting students' voices at MC by implementing PLC Action Plan in alignment with Dr. Pollard's vision, API Taskforce goals, and MC 2020-2025 Strategic Plan
 - Expected Outcomes
 - Confirm parenting status and assess barriers
 - Family-friendly institution that provide financial supports responsive to parents and create networks for parents to remove social stigma
 - Identify mental health and well-being interventions
 - Add high-quality non-degree pathways for parents

- Leverage state and federal policy opportunities to support parent success
- Question – Is Ascend like being a part of Achieving the Dream? What are the benefits of being a part of Ascend?
 - Dr. Pollard is part of Presidential Leadership Circle for Ascend
 - Focused on initiatives involving parenting students
 - Receiving a lot of support and resources
- Question – What about male populations?
 - At the moment, no male students in task force but making sure to reach out to the entire student parent population.
- Question – How is success defined in this project?
 - Aligned with goals of MC students – completion

Information Technology Master Plan Update

- Encouraged to look over the IT Master Plan
- Information Technology Alignment and Planning (ITAP) – heavy contributors to the plan
 - Representatives from various areas of the College
 - Recommending body to the President
- IT Goals and Master Plan supports goals of the College’s Master Plan – equitable accessibility
- Will update and change over time based on needs
- Question – How much flexibility have we given ourselves?
 - Plan was centered with how we’re used to doing on campus – change was needed
 - Laptop and docking station – increased mobility
 - Not going back to the same environment – some people thrive in this situation
 - Innovation Studio or HyFlex Classroom
- Workday will be about 80% done in two weeks
 - Try to make it as easy as possible for everyone
 - Self-service and robust
