- **Board of Trustee Summary (Tonya Baker, Germantown Council Chair)** Report from the Board of Trustee Meeting on Monday, April, 18, 2022
 - Two Montgomery College students attended the Board of Trustee meeting. The students shared their experiences at the College and how grateful they were for the emergency financial assistance they received during the semesters. Such assistance made it possible for them to continue doing what they needed to do while in school. One of the students said that she thought Montgomery College is the BEST College in Maryland.
 - Modification to the Advancement Network Security Certificate. Modification to the Cloud Computing and Systems Administrator Certificate.
 - The Board voted to discontinue the Photographic Techniques Certificate. Students who were enrolled in the program are able to finish before it ends.

- Board of Trustees approved a proposal to eliminate the library fines and fees for overdue materials from the open shelf stacks. Technology equipment (laptops) and reserved material will still incur late fees.
- No increase of tuition for FY 23.
- Approved the collective bargaining agreement.
