Call to Order

Chair Steve Taylor called the meeting to order at 2:06pm. The agenda was approved as written.

Constituent Concerns

- Concern raised about the temperature of water in HU and MT. A faculty member reported that hot water was consistently available in the bathrooms and there was a concern about health implications. Exact locations were unknown. Facilities will look into standards of water temperatures and investigate.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes for March and April were approved with amendments.

Rockville Facilities Update- James Gillis

James Gillis presented a facilities update:

- Commencement planning activities include the track is closed, parking lots 2 and 3 are closed for large equipment and tent construction.
- Student Services building construction is going well and on schedule for January 2020.

- Soccer field will be installed and is taking the place of the baseball field behind PAC
- Lot 9 will be paved in July
- PE building roof repairs this summer will affect summer programs

Provost Report- Kim Kelley

Dr. Kelley presented an update highlighting the following:

- A 34ft high T-Rex replica was installed in Science Center foyer.
- There was a debrief on lock down drill to receive feedback. This drill is required annually by federal and state law.
- Convocation is May 15th 4:00 PAC, 200 awards will be issued to graduating students.
- Harry Hearden awards will take place on May 14th at 4:00 in the tent.
- MC Advocate did an article about lighting in North Garage. The community had an issue with the brightness of the lights on the 7th floor, so the lights were turned off while awaiting approval from city of Rockville to install lower voltage lights.
- Dr. Kelley thanked the group for its service
- End of year picnic will be noon on May 16th on the MT terrace.
