Teamwork Badge Rubric

The Teamwork Badge recognizes students who demonstrate the ability to collaborate effectively, manage team dynamics, and contribute to shared goals in professional and academic settings. This self-paced, competency-based learning experience is delivered through a Pressbook format as part of the Proactive Thinker Microcredential series. To earn the badge, students must accumulate at least 15 points, with all competencies rated Competent (3) or above, and complete all required activities in the self-paced Pressbook.
