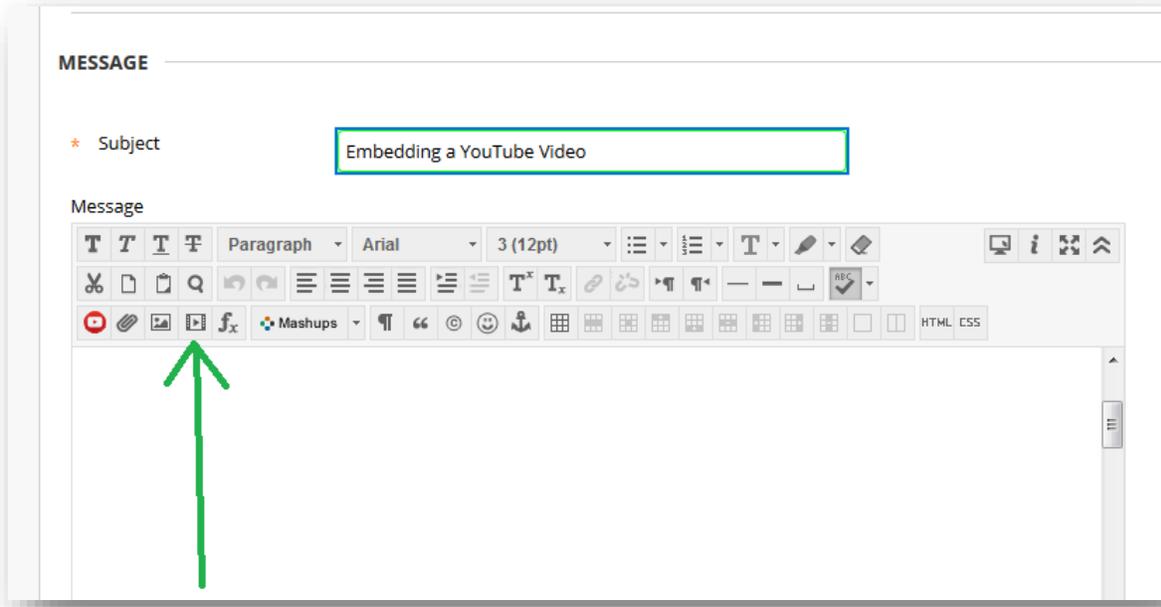


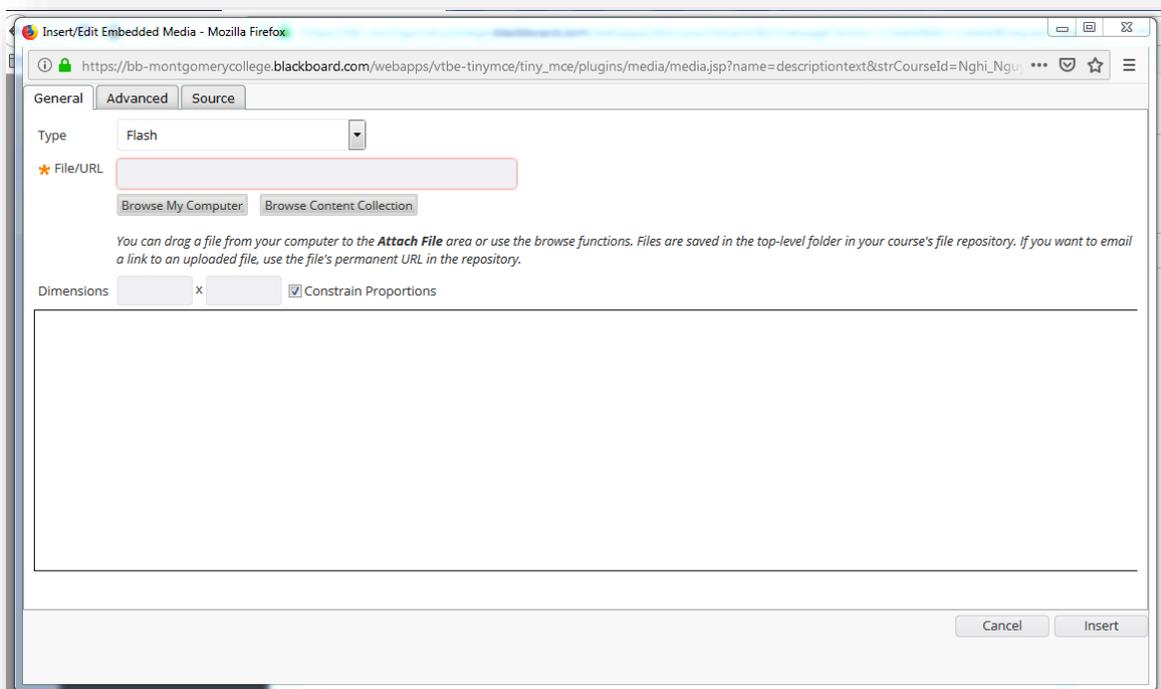
Tutorial 10 - Embedding YouTube Video in Blackboard

The following instructions will guide you on how to embed a YouTube video into your Blackboard course.

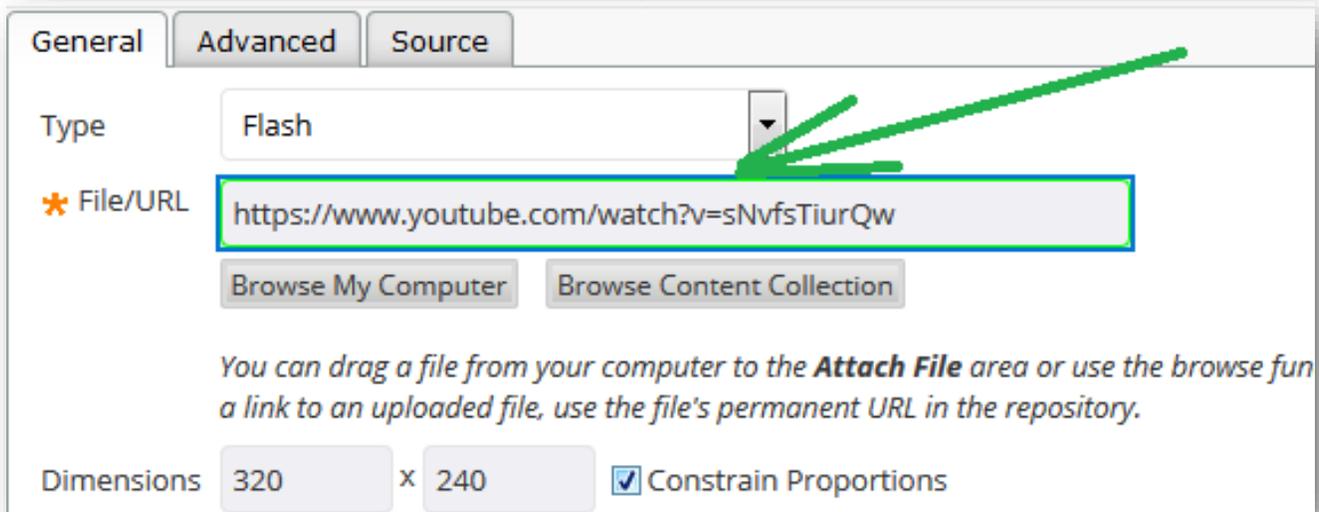
In the editor, select the Insert/Edit Embedded Media button.



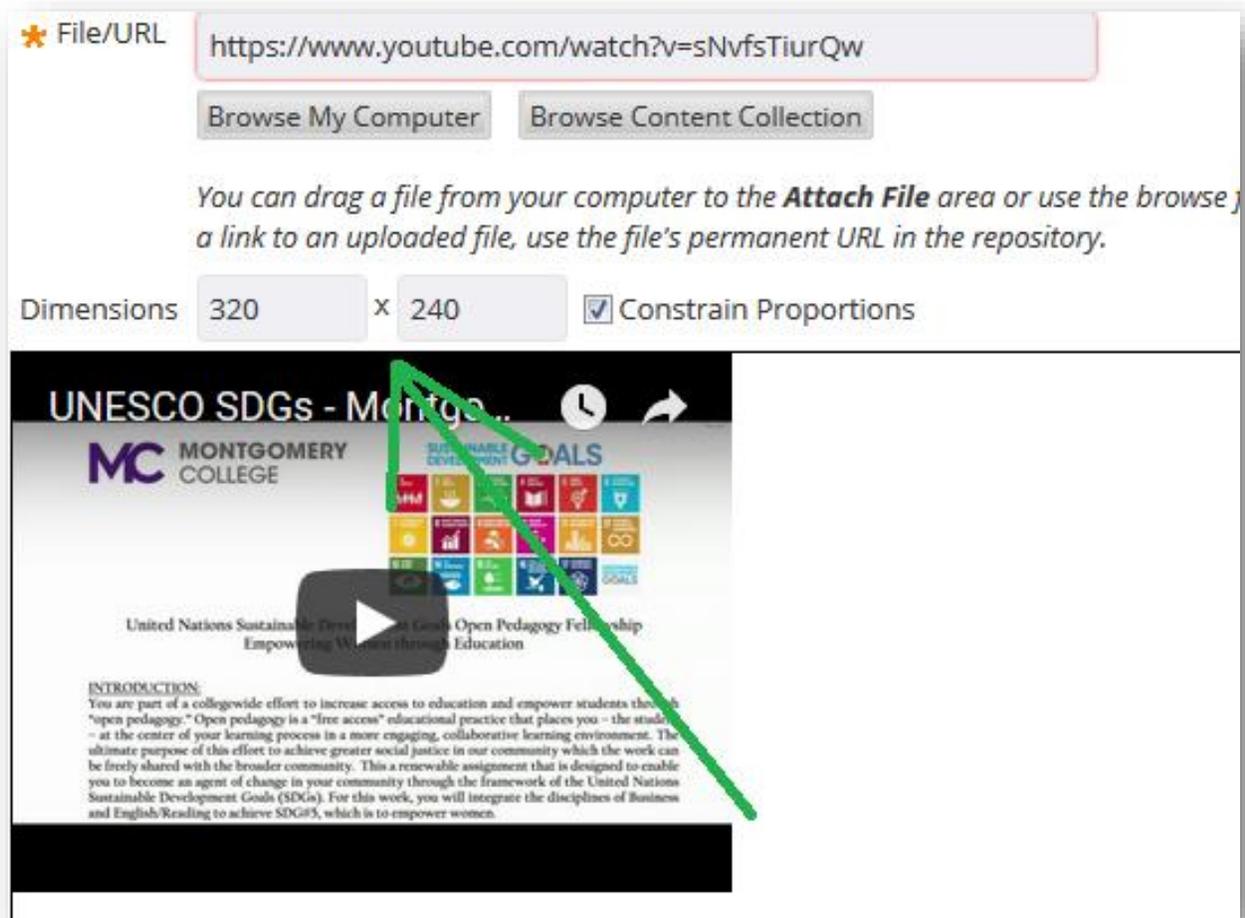
A screen will pop up.



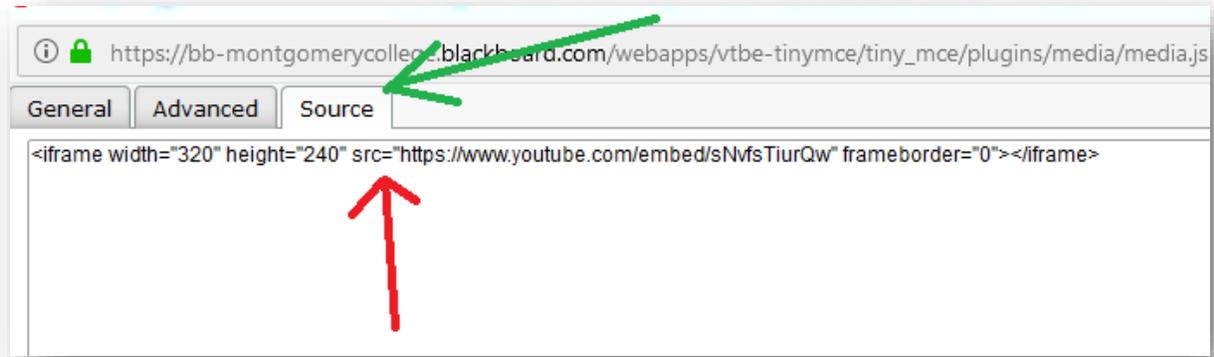
Copy the URL address of your video and paste it into the **File/URL** box.



You can change the dimension of the video if you want.



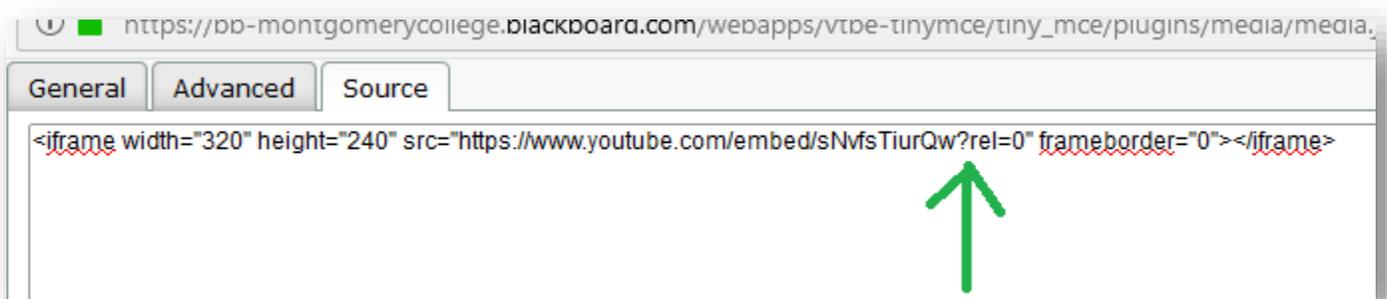
Now click on **Source**.



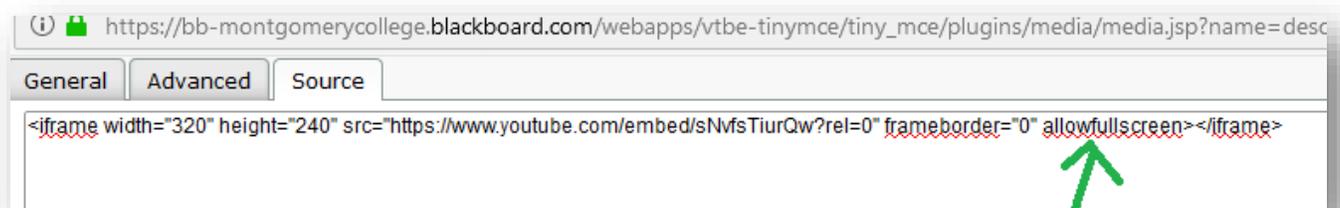
Under Source, you will see the HTML code setting for your video. This is where you can do several things.

1. Disable related video suggestions after the video ends
2. Enable Full Screen

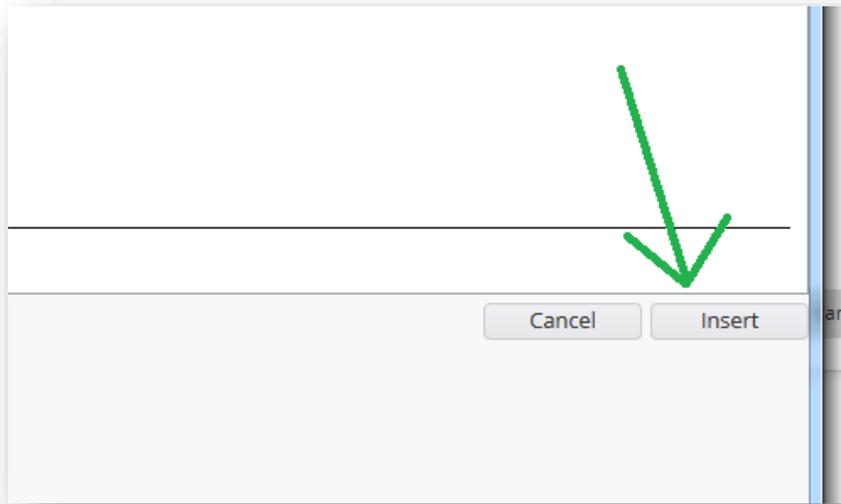
To Disable related video suggestions, add **?rel=0** at the end of your YouTube video URL



To Enable Full Screen, add in the phrase **allowfullscreen**



Now click **Insert** to finish.



Once you click **Submit**, you should see the video.
